TEXT FOR TODAY'S WORSHIP

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE: Ruth 2:14-20a

At mealtime Boaz said to her, "Come here, and eat some of this bread, and dip your morsel in the sour wine." So she sat beside the reapers, and he heaped up for her some parched grain. She ate until she was satisfied, and she had some left over. When she got up to glean, Boaz instructed his young men, "Let her glean even among the standing sheaves, and do not reproach her. You must also pull out some handfuls for her from the bundles, and leave them for her to glean, and do not rebuke her."

So she gleaned in the field until evening. Then she beat out what she had gleaned, and it was about an ephah of barley. She picked it up and came into the town, and her mother-in-law saw how much she had gleaned. Then she took out and gave her what was left over after she herself had been satisfied. Her mother-in-law said to her, "Where did you glean today? And where have you worked? Blessed be the man who took notice of you." So she told her mother-in-law with whom she had worked, and said, "The name of the man with whom I worked today is Boaz." Then Naomi said to her daughter-in-law, "Blessed be he by the Lord, whose kindness has not forsaken the living or the dead!"

The BOOK of RUTH

In most Christian Bibles, the Book of Ruth appears between Judges and 1 Samuel. It serves as a transition from an Israel ruled by judges to a nation led by kings. At the end of this short book, Ruth gives birth to Obed, father of Jesse, and grandfather of the future King David.

In this story, we see themes of family, fidelity, and faithfulness. Underneath it all is a God on the move, working in the lives of insignificant people of Judah to bring about new leadership for a struggling people.
